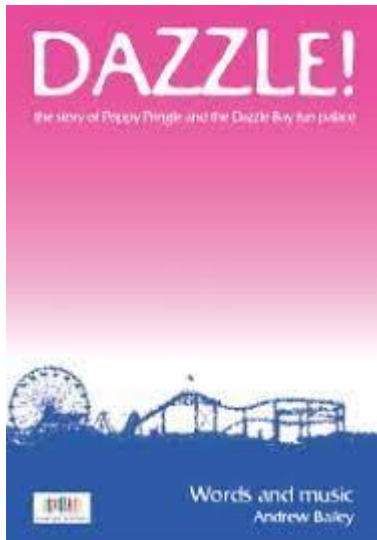

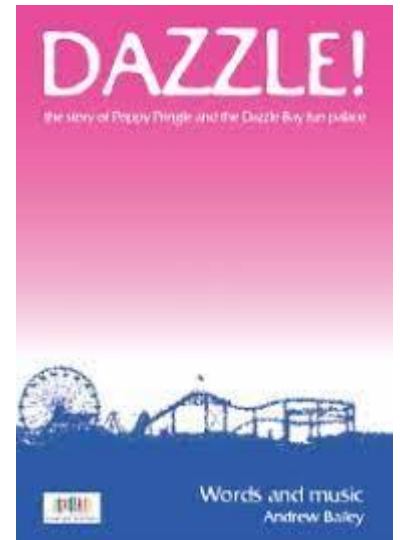


Roll up! Roll up! Get your tickets here...

Thank you to everyone who helped at our recent family cleaning day.

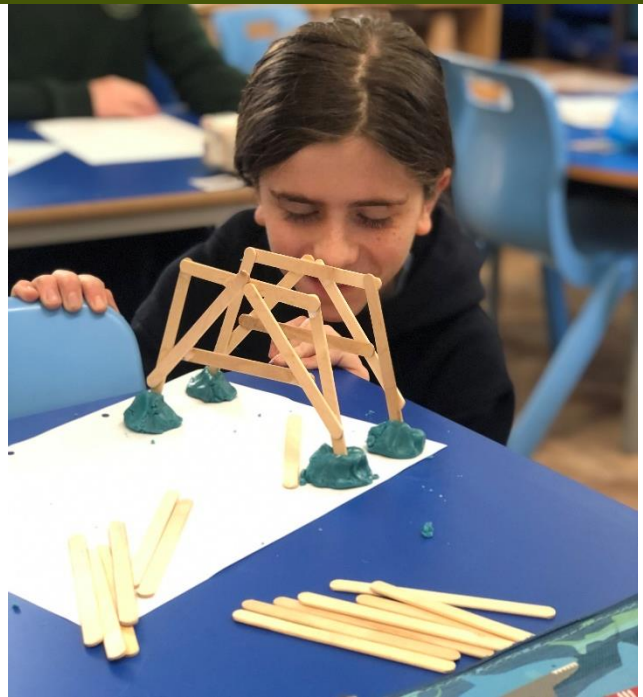
These school community days are at the heart of TCST. A chance for us to come together for a common goal whilst saving on the expense of employing commercial contractors.

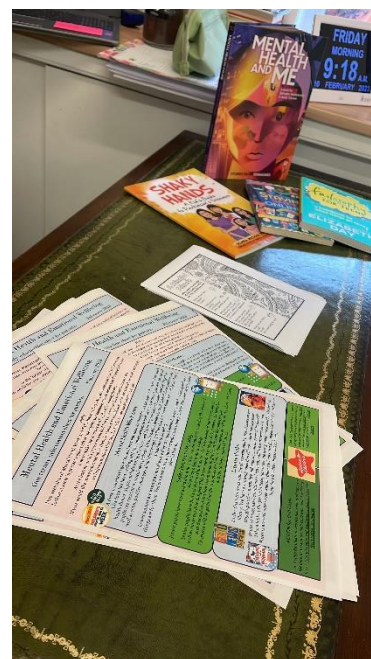
At this morning's family assembly our Y7 & Y8 pupils gave a very informative presentation on Internet Safety.
